Hispanic Outreach Services Celebrates Cinco de Mayo

Hispanic Outreach Services, an agency of Catholic Charities of Albany, is celebrating Cinco de Mayo in remembrance of the victory that the Mexican had over the French on May 5th, 1862. Today, the victory is about bringing health awareness among the Latinos in the Capital District communities.

The celebration begins in Amsterdam on Tuesday, May 5th (Cinco de Mayo) at the Amsterdam Housing Authority, 52 Division Street in the Community Room. The celebration will be from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. Albany will also celebrate Cinco de Mayo in a separate celebration on May 28th.

Hispanic Outreach Services is working in collaboration with community program, Cancer Services Program of Fulton and Montgomery Counties, who offer comprehensive health information on cancer screenings in the two-county area.
